Meeting was called to order by Chris Walters, President, at 3:04 PM.

1. Hear from the public - none

2. Board Action

a. Approve minutes from the February 4, 2015 meeting:

Action: Motion was made by Janet Clark to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by Chris Walters.

Discussion: none. Board approved unanimously.

b. TBID financial statements for December, 2014:

Action: Motion made by Janet Clark to approve the financials. Motion seconded by Chris Walters. Discussion: none. Board approved unanimously.

c. Approval of FY'16 projected revenue for budget planning

Action: Motion was made by Chris Walters to set FY'16 Revenue Projection at \$525,000. Motion seconded by Dawn Hendrickson.

Discussion: Board decided to drop FY'16 revenue projection to \$525K due to decreased Canadian traffic caused by weakened Canadian dollar. Board approved unanimously.

d. Approval of support for LC1130

Action: Motion was made by Dawn Hendrickson to support LC1130. Motion seconded by Janet Clark.

Discussion: TBID will sign letter of support. Members will be notified of hearing date. Board approved unanimously.

3. Board Discussion

- a. Sales Manager Position: Dawn Jackson, currently Director of Sales at The Lodge at Whitefish Lake, has accepted the position. Her start date will be March 16, 2015.
- b. Pond Hockey updates: 60 teams have registered; deadline is February 8. There will be 6 rinks plus a community skating rink. An eblast highlighting lodging packages will be sent to team captains February 6 and another will go out prior to the event.
- c. Press Trips (FAM): KCVB has partnered with <u>Tom Gruenwold Outdoors</u> on the Sportsman Channel and A Able Fishing to sponsor a drawing for a backcountry ice fishing trip. Contest winners will be in Kalispell February 23 26. <u>Winter Travel Writers FAM</u> will take place the week of February 24th. Four writers who focus on extreme outdoor winter sports will experience cat skiing, cross-country

- skiing in Glacier Park and downhill at Whitefish Mountain Resort. The editor of <u>National Park</u> <u>Traveler</u> will visit Glacier Park the end of February. He'll snowshoe with Superintendent Jeff Mow and the head ranger. Glacier Country and MTOT are helping with costs.
- d. Dragon Boat Location: an application for a Conditional Use Permit for the Lakeside location was submitted to the county. While reviewing the application, the Planning Office realized they were not able to do an administrative CUP in Lakeside so the application will go before the Board of Adjustments in April, then to the County Commissioners. Information packets have been sent to all adjacent property owners. There will be a public meeting in Lakeside, probably on February 24.
- e. Meetings and Conventions: Diane is coordinating several RFP's that have been received from various groups. RFP's for the Dragon Bash have been received and will be sent to the committee. Planning for FY'16 will be completed when Dawn Jackson comes on board.
- f. Marketing Updates: The Montana Pond Hockey Classic received a full page "Best of the West" recognition in <u>Sunset Magazine</u> and was featured in <u>Northwest Travel Magazine</u>.

 Contacts for these articles were made as a result of Diane's participation in travel media events in the fall. Kalispell was also featured in <u>Group Tour Magazine</u>. Staff completed the enhancement of the high-traffic <u>Shopping Page</u> on discoverkalispell.com to highlight 12 categories of retail businesses. The <u>Winter Online Campaign</u> will continue through February focusing on boosting the direct Chicago flight. <u>Glacier Aero</u> will meet to identify the next target markets Texas and Portland are being considered. Cindy Martin is recommending that the group study increasing flight frequency in a current market, rather than move on to a new market at this time.

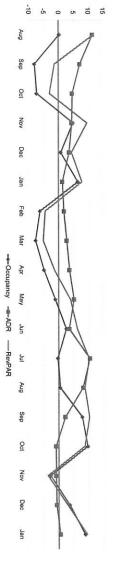
