Board of Directors Meeting Kalispell Tourism Business Improvement District Kalispell Chamber of Commerce October 1, 2014

Minutes

Board Members Present: Chris Walters, Janet Clark, Gib Bissell, Vanessa Nordahl, Dan Moderie

Board Members Absent: Lisa Brown

Meeting was called to order by Chris Walters, Chairman of the Board at 3:15 PM.

1. Hear from the public – none

2. Board Action

a. Approve Minutes from the August 6, 2014 meeting:

Action: Motion was made by Gib Bissell to approve the minutes. Motion seconded by Janet Clark. Discussion: none. Board approved unanimously.

b. TBID financial statements for July and August, 2014:

Action: Motion made by Janet Clark to approve the financials. Motion seconded by Dan Moderie. Discussion: none. Board approved unanimously.

c. Approval of application for board seat vacated by Lori Fisher:

Discussion: Vanessa Nordahl resigned as General Manager of Homewood Suites (medium property category) and accepted General Manager's position at the Hampton Inn (large property category). Proposed that Vanessa switch her board position to Hampton Inn, large category, then put out announcement of board vacancy for medium property.

Action: Tabled until November meeting.

3. Board Discussion

- a. Dragon Boat report: 73 teams participated. Number of local teams decreased but same level of OOM teams as last year. 32 total OOM teams, of which 23 were from Canada. ITRR is tabulating survey results. Strong room night reporting from economy hotels, weaker from higher end properties. \$99 rate seems to be division point. Bigfork hotels claimed to be sold out although Janet observed few cars at Marina Cay. May want to approach Bigfork hotels about a rebate program for future events there. Staff is evaluating new locations for the 2015 festival that could potentially reduce or eliminate the need for TBID's financial contribution and address several logical issues.
- b. Pond Hockey: Registration opened today, 6 teams registered. Promoter Scott Crowder is estimating 80-100 teams this year, approximately a 40% increase. Last year, out-of-market participation was 90%. Andy Hergesheimer will be hired for ice maintenance and management. \$12,000 marketing grant has been applied for from Montana Office of Tourism. Tamarack Brewing Co. is onboard as title sponsor again this year. Staff will meet with Flathead Valley Hockey Assn to discuss their involvement and potential of evening, ancillary event.

- c. Other Events: <u>Cinch Bucking Horse Championship</u>: taking place Oct. 4-5 at Majestic Valley Arena, richest bucking horse event in North America. Sponsored by Cinch again. This year they are adding a bucking horse sale on Sunday. <u>Western B Basketball Tournament</u>, February 16-21, Flathead High School. <u>Montana Spartan Race</u>, May 9-10, 2-day event this year, adding the Spartan Beast (5/9) which will attract more out-of-market participants. Projected attendance for 2015 two day event is 8,500.
- d. Cultural Exhibit: staff researched viability of Bodies Revealed cultural exhibit. Results showed a projected revenue/expense variance of \$48,000. Board agreed to not proceed with this exhibit. Concept is good and staff will continue to look for less expensive exhibit options.
- e. Meetings & Conventions Updates: staff is refining database and segmenting list of drive market prospects, targeting organizations with attendees of 500 or fewer and will start a CRM campaign to database every other month. Rob will represent KCVB at IMEX America Show in Las Vegas, October 14-16 partnering with Glacier County and Missoula and Whitefish CVB's. KCVB will offer \$10,000 credit to conference organizer's master account as booking incentive. 2,600 planners at the IMEX Conference, 900 destinations represented. KCVB criteria are meetings for 500 or less with open RFP. Rob will have 25+ 1:1 meetings with planners that meet that criteria.
- f. Marketing Updates: Diane will attend travel media events in Portland/Seattle, October 21-22 and San Francisco, November 6. This is a coop with Glacier Country and Montana Office of Tourism is involved with Seattle and San Francisco. Approximately 25 media at each event, one on one time to promote Kalispell and provide story pitch ideas and content. Winter Travel Writers FAM - week of February 24, 2015. Focus is on outdoor winter sports. Results from Fall FAM 2014 - articles in Canadian Geographic, Via, Huffington Post, Dreamscapes, Country Magazine. Fall & Winter <u>Promotion</u> - focus on attracting shoppers in our drive market using database of 7,300 e-subscribers. banner ads and our website. Kalispell Discoveries Badge_ – a free program allowing area merchants to generate additional business from tourism throughout the year. Visitors will be able to download to a mobile device or print a badge that will encourage them to explore local businesses and receive special offers. KCVB has partnered with Orbitz and Montana Office of Tourism allowing the purchase of \$15,000 worth of ads for \$5,000. This month, Tom Gruenwald's Outdoors on the Sportsman's Channel will premier an ice fishing show featuring a 90 second highlight about Kalispell. The episode will include a 30 second ad and a destination contest offering a fishing trip to Kalispell as the prize. To help promote the show and the contest KCVB will assist to sponsor Mike Howe and AAble Fishing in his attendance at sportsman/fishing shows over the next few months. Montana Office of Tourism is offering a workshop on welcoming Chinese visitors to the state, October 15 at the Hilton Garden Inn. Star Report. KCVB has added a report by property class which appears on the multi-segment portion of the report. It provides occupancy, ADR and RevPAR for economy properties as a group and mid/upper/upscale properties as a group.

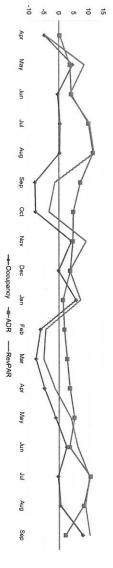
